2018 Staffing

What do Rochester, Mexico City, Auckland and Charlottsville, all have in common? They are just a few of the home towns of our staff members for 2018. We employ 70 camp counselors and 7 administrative counselors each summer from all over the world.

Every year we receive significant numbers of applications from former campers. This overflowing of Skylake enthusiasm and history provide the backbone for our staff. They arrive for staff training already aware of the magic and only need to be trained in the job elements. Sometimes this can be a rude awakening since being on staff is *very different* than being a camper.

Typically, about 1/3 of our staff is returning from a previous summer. Being invited back is **not automatic**. Our rule of thumb is that we would rather train an enthusiatic new staff member instead of inviting back a counselor that was just "ok" or "average."

One of the joys of the week of Staff Training is getting to know our "newbies." These are staff that only know of Skylake from word of mouth or what they have seen on our website. They bring incredible energy and excitement to our program. Skylake receives over 200 inquiries for our job openings. Skype is our best friend in the winter as we get to know these applicants.

We also always look for a little European flair for staff and we normally accomplish this by visiting a camp job fair in London. Adrienne will be heading there next month with the goal of hiring five or six Brits anxious to escape the cold English summers to summer life in California.

It is not just the campers that get excited as summer approaches, the staff are just as excited.

Staff Training Excitement for 2018

A considerable amount of time is spent during the winter months planning for the 10 days of staff training that occurs prior to the campers arriving. It is a complex planning exercise due to the variety of issues that need to be covered. We need to cover everything from the mundane but critical issues of how our dining room functions to the more critical issues of how to communicate our core values and how to insure the health and safety of opers. We also spend considerable time on team

our campers. We also spend considerable time on team building exercises. A critical element to our success is getting all of our staff working as a unit.

Every year we evaluate the success of our prior years' workshops and then review and revise as we deem appropriate. It is critical that we rethink all of our training every year to keep it fresh and exciting. This year is no exception and we are very proud to once again be bringing to our training one of the nationally known experts in camp life and child psychology, Bob Ditter.

Bob has over 25 years of experience as a child, adolescent and family therapist. He has been the "go to" expert for the American Camp Association and Western Association of Independent Camps for many years. He has visited over 500 camps. Bob's workshops at ACA and WAIC are always "standing room only". Bob is headquartered in Boston and getting him to the west coast during staff training weeks is very difficult. Hundreds of camps are seeking Bob's assistance. We have been patiently waiting over five years to get included on Bob's calendar.

Bob will be providing us two full days of his expertise. It is anticipated that he will be doing an initial workshop for our entire camp family, including our kitchen and housekeeping staff on the importance of a camp culture and the lasting gifts campers gain from a camp experience. We will also have targeted workshops on typical characteristics of boys in the camp setting and how to work effectively with them. The same

topic will be presented for our girls. An entire afternoon is going to be spent on fundamental counselor skills.

This year's staff, and therefore all of our campers, are going to benefit from Bob's work in camp this June. We will also benefit for years to come by incorporating his teachings into future training programs.

The first of the new fun items in 2017 were the two tipis constructed on site. These are authentic Native American tipis that are rather dramatic. We have one tipi located in front of the lodge. It serves as a fun gathering spot and always is reserved early for cabin walk suppers. The second tipi is located up on our mountain platform and serves as the outpost for our Chipmunk and Chickadee expeditions. The tent is 18 feet in diameter and easily sleeps our campers and staff for this fun overnight trip.

We were able to salvage some of the tree trunks from the trees were took down for a variety of projects in camp. We constructed rustic frames for our dart board and tomahawk toss targets. We also constructed two heavy duty horseshoe pits.

We converted a large portion of the garage under the gatehouse into a Trips Kitchen. All of our out of camp trips are now served by this separate kitchen that is fully stocked with food and supplies. Having everything in one place and not inconveniencing the kitchen every time a trip goes out has made our trip planning much easier. Clean-up is also much easier with a great three sink set up now available exclusively for the trips counselors. Our out of camp trips program improves dramatically every year.

In 2018 we are doing a complete remodel of the craft shop. The remodel includes a sanding and varnish of the building exterior, new windows, construction of a small outside deck area, and the removal of the walls and ceiling to allow new insulation and lighting. It was a hard and difficult decision to update this element of Skylake lore. Those walls contained many stories and the artwork of countless campers. We are confident we will quickly introduce some new traditions in this space to make it as inviting as it was in the past.

We are working with our challenge course company to introduce a few new elements on the ropes course. The loss of trees definitely has us scrambling to make sure we are always not only replacing what we lose, but also adding to our course.

We will also be adding pickle ball tennis this summer. Plans also call for a complete renovation of the outdoor basketball court with new surface and new backboards along with the introduction of a pitching machine for both softball and hardball.

A new access ramp has been constructed at the docks for easier access and work will commence either this year or next on making our swim trail not only easier to walk on but much more beautiful.

There is true joy in continuing to upgrade the facilities and in adding more activities. Please be sure to provide us with any insight you glean from campers regarding what they would like to see in camp.



On Line Camper Photographs - More or Less?

It was only a few short years ago, with slow internet speeds that the issue of publishing camper photos from camp was not an issue, it simply was not technologically possible. Over the years with the development of photo software and increased internet speeds most camps now have the capability of posting almost unlimited photographs. The question is: Do we want to?

Skylake has always had a philosophy that we would try to find a compromise between satisfying the valid parent's desire to see their child and the need for camp to flow without "always being on stage." If the campers are always seeing a camera and being requested to pose, they are not being given the opportunity to truly engage in the camp life.

We have reached a comfortable compromise on this issue. Skylake seeks to post approximately 100 photos per day. The photos are normally taken in a non-obtrusive manner. We normally do not seek out campers to pose for the camera, and instead seek to take very quick and unposed photos. By taking photos at one of our daily group settings, such as morning or evening flag, the dining room, or evening campfire we can get groups of campers. This gives us the ability to show a lot of faces in a quick and easy process.

> We know as a parent you are desirous of seeing your child when you go to the website. You probably want to see your child every day that you go to the website, and are probably disappointed every day that you don't. It is certainly not our goal to frustrate a parent. The problem is the conflict between a camp core value and the parent's desire to see more photographs.

> > We have recently been confronted with this issue by a marketing company very desirous of having us buy into their system of facial recognition. They rightfully point out that they would save a lot of parent's aggravation by allowing the system to ID a child and then automatically send the photo the parent's cell phone. Wow, how nice would that be? Very convenient, but now setting in motion a cause and effect where we would be seeking out every camper, every day, to meet the newly created daily "need" to see the child quickly and easily. Frankly, we do not like the idea.

> > > Our goal will be to continue the balance of providing daily shots of camp where you will hopefully get the joy

of seeing your child. Some children actually avoid having their photo takenwe respect that. As in the past, if a after a few days you have not seen your child appear with the daily photos, give us a call, and we will always make sure to have them on line within

a day or two.



Bed Bugs - Lice - Cell Phones

Wow, isn't this article title disgusting. We consider all three of these plagues to be on equal standing in camp. They are all forbidden. We are very successful on two out three of these plagues, and are working hard on the third.

Although we do not believe bed bugs to be a problem we are always alert to the concern. Our cabins contain no fabrics, no unsealed mattresses, or carpets where bed bugs can lurk. Our cabins are open air and empty for 9 months of the year. We have freezing temperatures in the winter. Although not impossible, there is the possibility of bugs surviving year to year so we test for evidence of bed bugs prior to the season and periodically during the season. If we ever do find evidence of the critters we have the equipment to quickly eradicate by tenting the cabin and forcing in hot air that is 100% effective in eliminating. We have never needed that so

far, but we are ready.

Lice on the other hand do come into camp on campers' heads occasionally. Our protocol is to check everyone's head upon arrival as part of the initial health check. Only rarely do we encounter the issue. Most the time when we have encountered lice in camp it has been with siblings. Close physical contact is the source of spreading far more than the widely perceived belief it is from sharing hair brushes. As a preventative for lice and miscellaneous viruses, every two week session we empty every cabin and do a

thorough cleaning and a liberal use of bleach spray for sanitizing.

That gets us to cell phones. This is the only plague that continues to appear in camp. Our efforts are getting more and more effective, but unfortunately it is a topic that needs to be continually stressed. The elimination of cell phones and tablet screens is critical to our camp culture. Please help us and join us in making camp 100% free of these devices. Camp really starts the moment the campers get on the bus and doesn't end until they are home. We would strongly urge parents to make sure your camper does not come to camp with a cell phone or any device "capable" of accessing the internet or wifi. Campers with air transportation issues may have their phones kept for them in the office, while all other phones that arrive at camp will be mailed home.
